Sir Lancelot's son, Sir Galahad, was the bravest knight in the world.

4. Arthur's enemies were Morgan Le Fay, his half-sister, and Mordred, her son. After many battles, it was Mordred who finally killed Arthur. Before Arthur died, he asked one of his knights to throw Excalibur back into the lake. As the knight threw the sword, a hand came up from the lake to catch it.
